Harvest Type = CLEARCUT WITH RESERVES

Harvest and Reserves
BLOCK 1 (West Block) - Harvest all Tamarack, Spruce, Aspen, Balm, Ash, Maple, & Balsam Fir 2 sticks and greater. Reserve non-merchantable timber less than 2 sticks, advanced regeneration, and snags. Within tamarack cover type reserve one fully-crowned seed tree every 70 feet.
BLOCK 2 (East Block) - Clearcut all Black Spruce & Tamarack stems greater than 5 feet tall.

Access
Closest access from the north of the tamarack stand (Block 1) through Blandin Paper Company land. Access from the northwest is down pipeline winter road through Great Lakes Gas Trans. land on CR 429. Public access from the west down snowmobile trail off CR 428 on the Aitkin County line.
Private / Easement road must be used to access the timber sale. Access road must be kept in good condition at all times.
Snowmobile trail regulations in Itasca County Forest Management Guideline & Specifications apply. A minimum of two inches of compacted snow must remain on the trail as a running surface.
It is the permit holder's responsibility to obtain approval from all affected landowners and/or management agencies before gaining access to the permit area. The permit holder shall pay all access fees and road charges.
0.35 miles to CR 429 from the north through Blandin Paper Company land. 0.95 miles to CR 429 from the northwest down pipeline winter road through Great Lakes Gas Trans land. 2 miles to CR 428 to the west down snowmobile trail through County land.

Landings and Access Roads

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.
 Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition before performance bond is returned.
 Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage unmarked trees, regeneration, or reserve trees.
 Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees.
 Sale boundaries painted ORANGE SLASHES (///) & property boundaries painted ORANGE CIRCLES (oOo). Natural Boundaries are shown on Sale Map.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

Special Conditions

BLOCK 2 (East Block) - All Black Spruce stems greater than 5ft. must be severed. Mistle Toe prevention

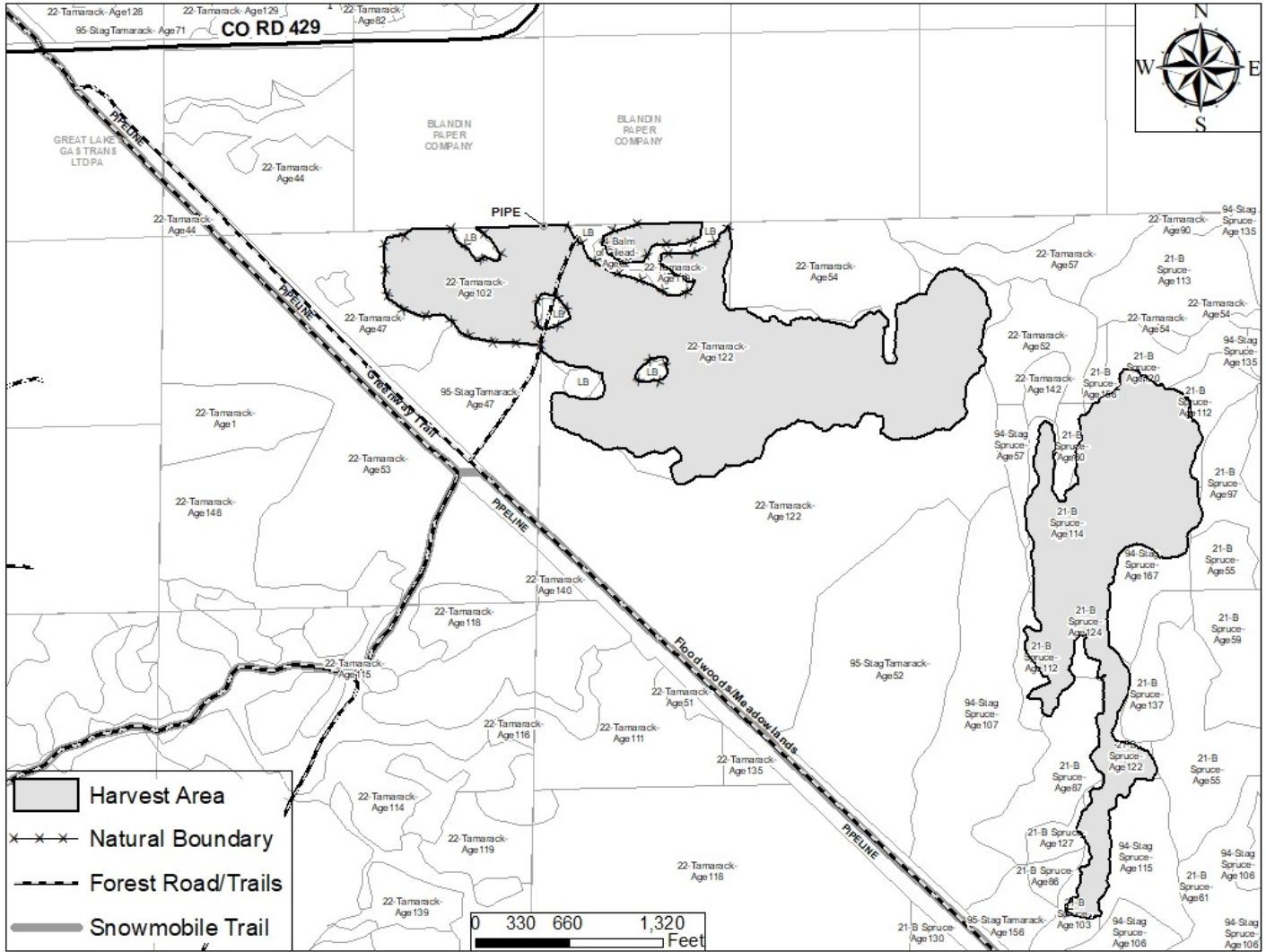
