Comments
Harvest Type: Aspen Clearcut with reserves

Harvest and Reserves
Harvest all Aspen, Balm, Ash, Birch, Maple and Balsam Fir.
Reserve all Oak, Basswood, Cedar and Elm
Reserve all non-hazardous snags.

Access
Access is directly onto Tax Forfeit via an existing woods road

Landings and Access Roads
Landings must be kept back at least 100' from the Decker Lake Road.
Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

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Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage reserve trees.
 Do not fell timber into wetlands or across sale boundaries.
 Sale property boundaries painted with orange circles.
 Sale cutting boundaries painted with orange vertical slashes.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands.
 Roads and skid trails must be stabilized. This may involve installing water bars, strike outs, and/or mulching and seeding.
 Reserve all non-merchantable timber within 15ft of all wetlands.
 Reserve all non-merchantable timber within 30ft of the Decker Lake Road.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.
 A 10 ft. wide slash free zone must be maintained along roads and trails.
 Slash height must not exceed 3 ft. within view of road.

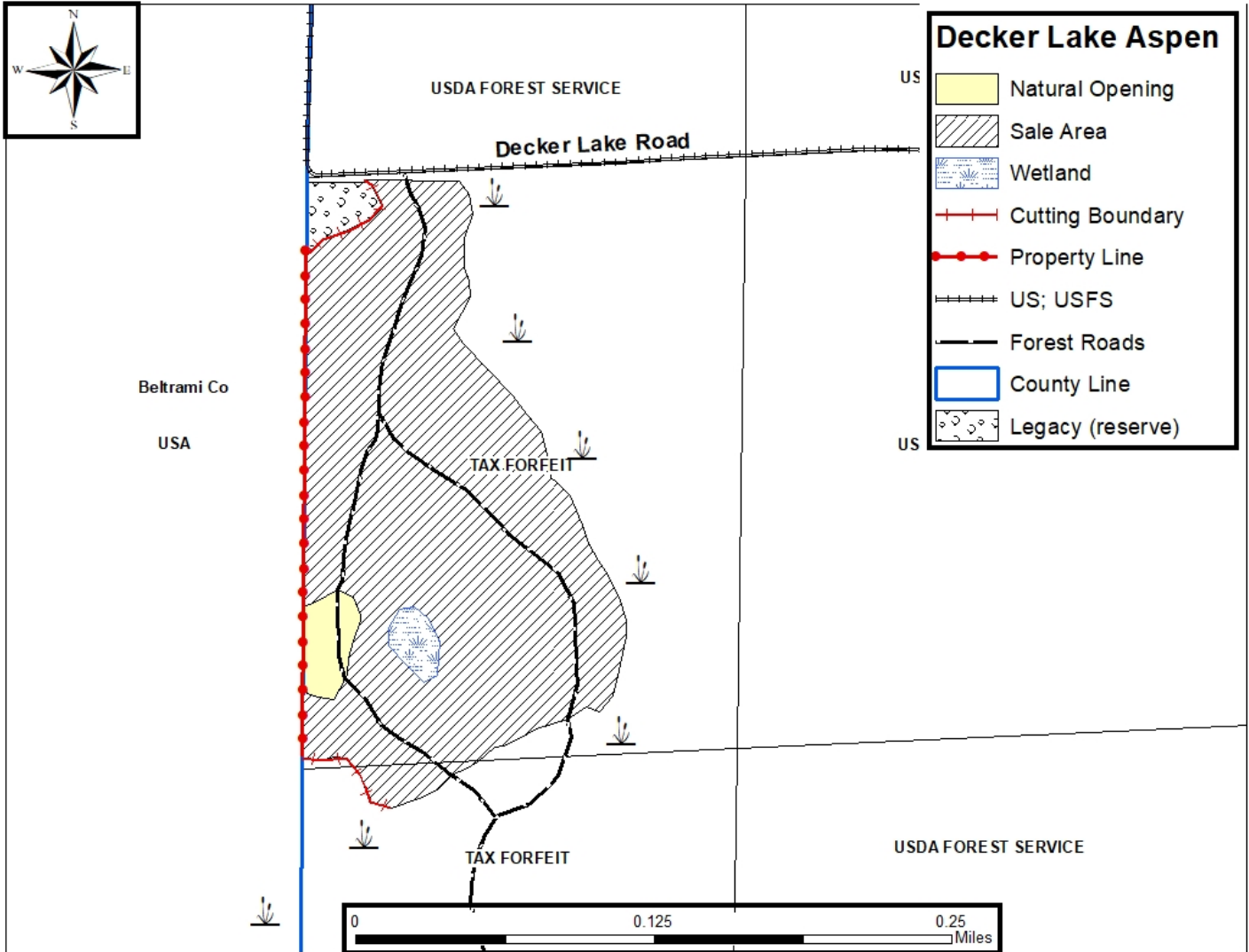
Regeneration Plan
