Comments
Harvest type: Marked hardwood thin

Harvest and Reserves
Cut all stems ringed with orange paint. Reserve all non-hazardous snags. Trees marked with "R" are to be reserved for wildlife.

Access
Gate must be locked at all times, except on days when 3 or more loads are hauled.

Landings and Access Roads
Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition, determined by administering forester, before performance bond is returned. Cross country ski trails are located within the permit area. Unless required, operator should avoid use of these roads as landings and with equipment. Roads and landings must be approved by sale administrator. Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

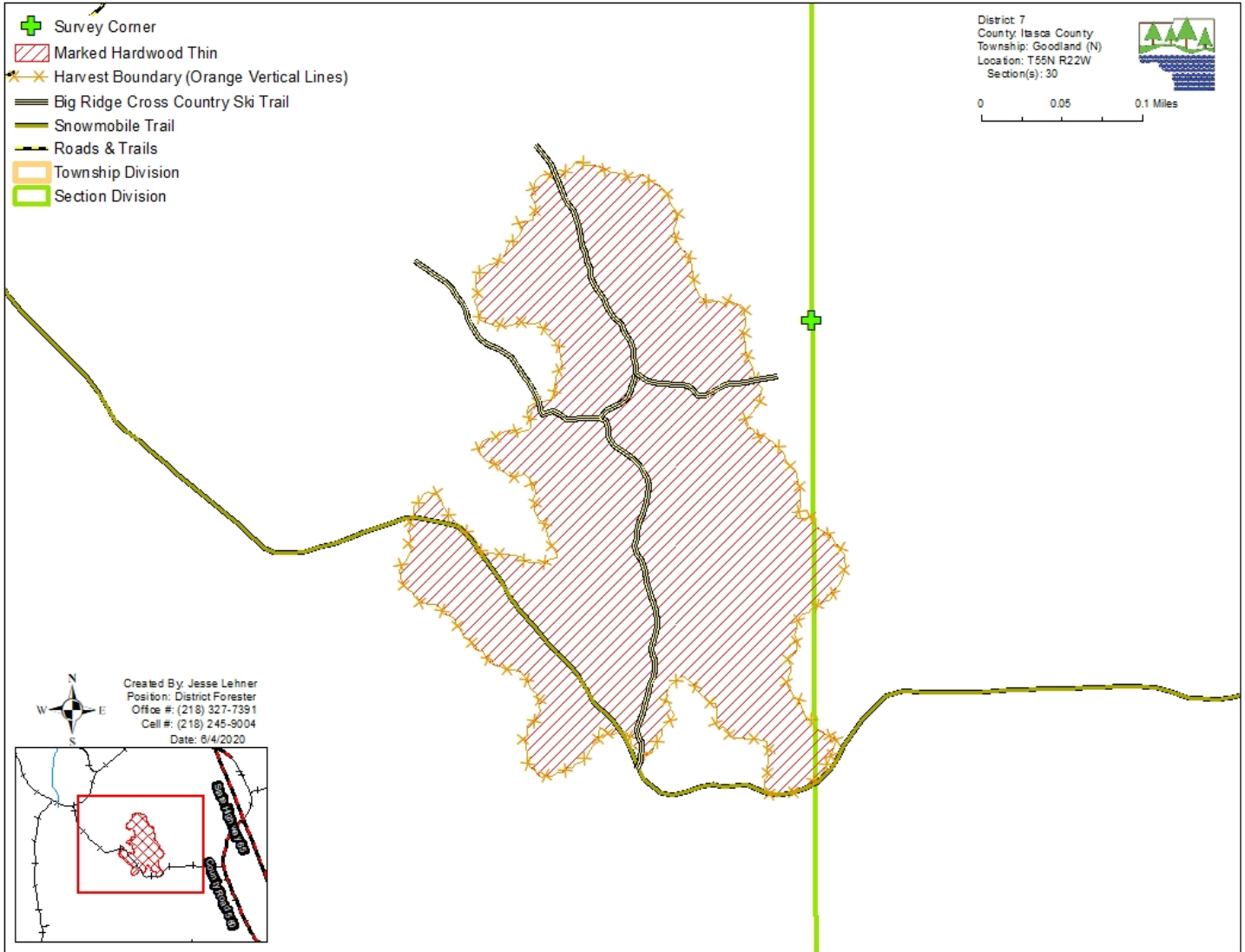
