Harvest and Reserves

Reserve Oak, Pine, Basswood, & Snags. Reserve Balsam & Spruce less than 2 sticks.

Access

0.5 miles to public road CR 72.

Access to the 2 northern units is off Sago Twp 6 Road. The 3 southern units are accessed using existing winter road through bog.

Landings and Access Roads

Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition, determined by administering forester, before performance bond is returned.

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Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage reserve trees.

Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees.

Sale boundaries painted Orange Slashes (III) or Natural boundaries. Property boundaries painted Orange Circles (oOo).

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.


