Harvest Type: Operator select second time pine thin.

Harvest and Reserves

Harvest: In east block, use existing cut strips to thin timber. Western 2 blocks don't have existing strips; cut 12' access strips every 40' and thin between. In all blocks, focus removal of suppressed and defective trees of all species to a target of 100 BA. Cut older pines if younger crop trees will be released.

Reserve all non-hazardous snags.

Access

0.1 miles to County Road 550.

Access and landing trail is also Thistledew ATV trail; ATV regulations in Itasca County Forest Management Guideline & Specifications apply. State must be crossed to access timber sale. Logger must obtain permits/permission from land manager.

Landings and Access Roads

No construction of any new roads/landings will be permitted. Do not skid on ATV trail.

Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition, determined by administering forester, before performance bond is returned.

Reserve all non-merchantable timber within 15ft of ATV trails.

Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

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Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Timber must be processed at the stump.

Do not fell timber across sale/ownership boundaries.

Ownership boundaries painted with orange circles (O O O). Sale boundaries are unmarked; see sale map.

Regeneration Plan

Due to nature of managed species and type of harvest little to no tree regeneration is expected to occur after harvest.


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Site Map:
