HARVEST TYPE: RED PINE CLEARCUT WITH RESERVES

Public access road and campsite will be shut down for 1 week to allow the timber sale to be felled. Purchaser must give the forester at least 2 weeks notice before felling begins to allow the Land Dept. to post closing dates on the road and website. No logging will be allowed 3 days before and 3 days after holidays including fishing opener, Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day.

Harvest and Reserves

Trees marked with red paint around the campsite and water access are to be cut.

Access

Easement road (West Scooty Lake Road) must be used to access the timber sale. Access road must be kept in good condition, as determined by administering forester, at all times. No landing off of the public water access road.

.5 miles to county road 53.

Landings and Access Roads

All landings marked in yellow on the timber sale map must be used. Landings must be at least 100' off of the West Scooty Lake Road.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Full tree/whole tree skidding required across harvest area. Slash must be tightly piled at designated areas determined by the forester. 30% of the slash including breakage must be left scattered across the site.

Reserve 1 fully crowned white pine at least 12" in diameter every 100' where white pine exists. Reserve all white pine within 30' of electrical box. Reserve all dead snags away from the roads.

Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees.

Sale boundaries are painted in blue.

No skidding across the West Scooty Lake Road or the public water access road.

Slash Disposal

A 10 ft. wide slash free zone must be maintained along roads and trails.

Regeneration Plan

This site will be planted back to red pine.


