Landings must be kept back at least 100' from Co. Rd. 53.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Timber must be processed at the stump.

Do not damage "CROP" trees.

Using existing cut strips, thin stand down to an average of 100 basal area. Favor the removal of smaller diameter, poor quality, damaged trees, and trees over topping the red pine. Cut all jack pine, aspen, and birch in the stand south of the road.

Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees.

Sale boundaries are painted in orange or are natural boundaries.


