Comments
HARVEST TYPE: Aspen Clearcut w/reserves

Access
Access harvest area thru gravel pit on Hwy #65.

Landings and Access Roads
Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator. Berm(s) must be installed after sale is completed. Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding
Do not fell timber into wetlands or across sale boundaries. Reserve birch, cedar, ash less than 8" dbh and small balsam. Reserve snag and cavity trees when not a hazard. Most sale boundaries painted orange except for a natural boundary along the older aspen regeneration to south of large part of sale.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection
Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands.

Slash Disposal
Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

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Stand will naturally regenerate to aspen and black ash.

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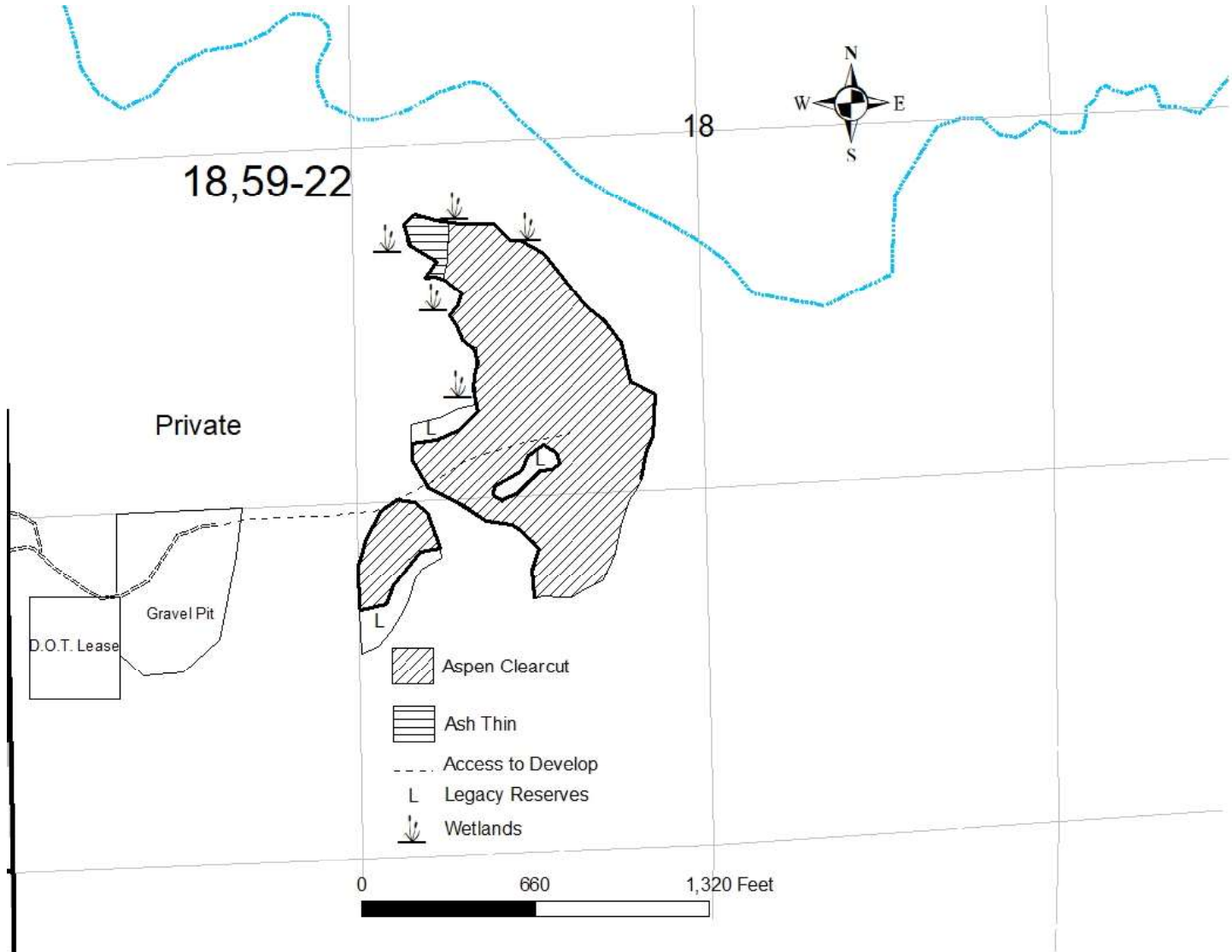
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Site Map:
