Comments
Harvest Type: Aspen Clearcut w/reserves
Harvest and Reserves
Reserve all non-hazardous snags/cavity trees, birch and small conifer.
Landings and Access Roads
Landing area is shown on map. No slash, bark to remain on landing area following sale activities. Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.
Cutting, Felling, and Skidding
Timber must be processed at the stump if logged during summer (7/1-10/1). If logged conventionally, logging season will be 12/1-3/1. Sale boundaries painted orange except along powerline.
Site, Soil, and Water Protection
Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands.
Slash Disposal
Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

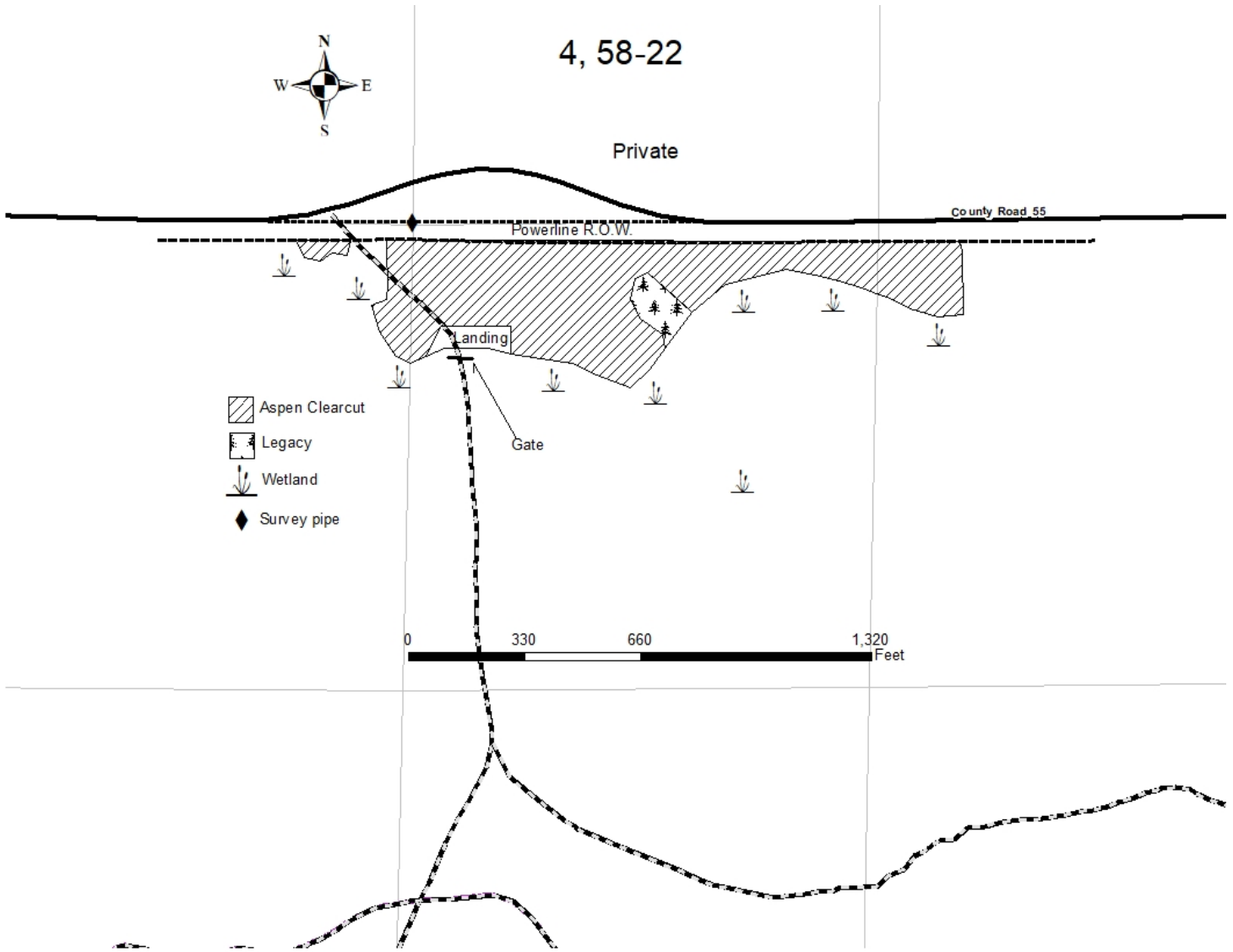
