HARVEST TYPE: Aspen Clearcut w/reserves

Harvest and Reserves

Reserve all non-hazardous snags/ cavity trees, pine and small conifer.

Access

On public road #58.

Access has two berms on old haul road that parallels #58 to remove and replace.

Landings and Access Roads

Roads and landings must be approved by sale administrator. If forwarding, wood can be piled along old haul road.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not fell timber into wetlands or across sale boundaries.

Sale boundaries painted orange.

Timber sale is on disturbed mining ground. Rocky and uneven ground which may require hand felling. Harvest would be better suited to using a processor/forwarder operation.

There is a fenceline (painted with some orange paint) along old haul road that will need some sections removed for harvesting timber. There is also another fenceline (used as the south cutting boundary) along the entire south line of sale.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands.

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Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

A 10 ft. wide slash free zone must be maintained along roads and trails.

Special Conditions

Sale area does have some smaller 2 stick trees to be utilized. There is a 20% reduction in stumpage for the site conditions and utilizing some smaller trees.


