HARVEST TYPE = Black spruce clearcut

Harvest and Reserves

Clearcut all black spruce and tamarack. Reserve all non-hazardous snags and den trees.

Access

Snowmobile trail regulations in Itasca County Forest Management Guideline & Specifications apply. A minimum of two inches of compacted snow must remain on the trail as a running surface. A "Caution Logging" sign must be placed at the southern entrance of the trail and north of the logging operation on the trail.

State land must be crossed to access timber sale. Logger must obtain permits/permission from state.

Landings and Access Roads

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition, determined by administering forester, before performance bond is returned.

Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not fell timber across property boundaries.

Do not disturb the survey marker, including witness trees, in the NW corner of the adjacent state clearcut.

Harvest lines and legacy patches are painted with 3 orange dashes (III). Property lines are painted with 3 orange circles (000).

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.


