Harvest Type: Aspen Clearcut with reserves (49.5 ac), Hardwood thin (3.9 ac), Hardwood Clearcut with reserves(2 ac)

#### **Harvest and Reserves**

Aspen clearcut with reserves block: Harvest all aspen and balm; Hardwood thin block: Harvest all aspen, ash and then basswood down to a 70 basal area; Hardwood clearcut with reserves block: Harvest all aspen, balm, ash and basswood.

Reserve all noncut species.

Reserve all non-hazardous snags.

#### Access

Federal land may be crossed to access timber sale. Logger must obtain permits/ permission from land owner/ land manager. This process has been started by Itasca Co.

## **Landings and Access Roads**

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition, determined by administering forester, before performance bond is returned

Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

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## Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage reserve trees.

Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees.

Sale property boundaries are painted with orange circles.

Sale cutting boundaries are natural boundaries and painted with orange lines except the north legacy patch is painted in blue slashes.

## Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands.

Reserve all non-merchantable timber within 15ft of all wetlands.

## **Slash Disposal**

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.


