Comments
Harvest Type: Aspen Clearcut with reserves

Harvest and Reserves
Harvest aspen, balm, birch, basswood, maple and ash. Reserve all other species Reserve all non-hazardous snags.

Access
State land must be crossed to access timber sale. Logger must obtain permits/ permission from land owner/ land manager. There is a locked gate at the start of the woods road leading into the sale. Contact the state DNR office in Blackduck for a key. (218-888-7730)

Landings and Access Roads
Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator. Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed. Reserve all non-merchantable timber within 15ft of all roads.

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### Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage reserve trees.  
 Do not fell timber into wetlands or across sale boundaries.  
 Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees.  
 Sale property boundaries are painted with 3 orange circles.  
 Sale cutting boundaries are painted with 3 orange slashes.

### Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Site will be harvested under frozen ground conditions only.  
 Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands.

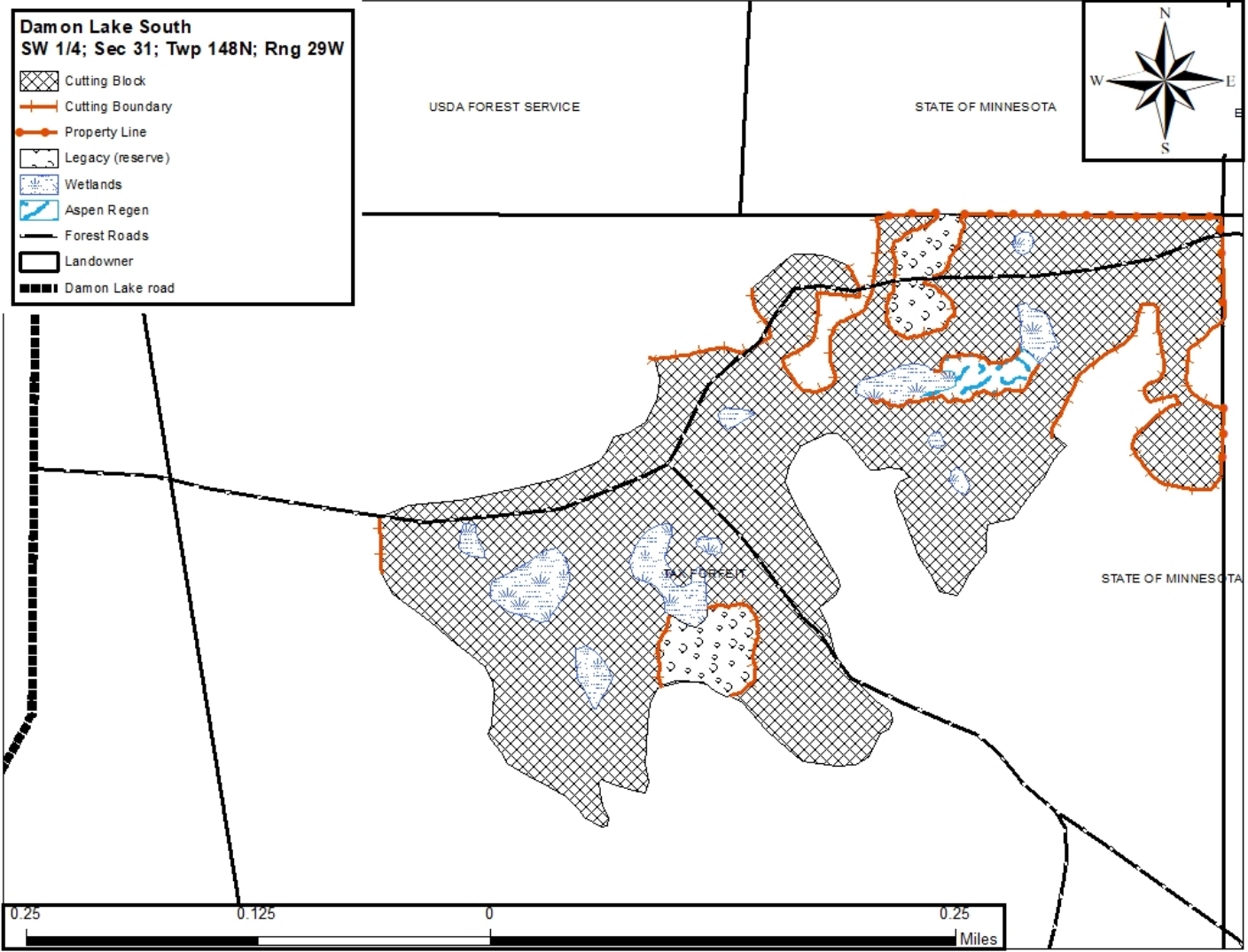
### Slash Disposal
