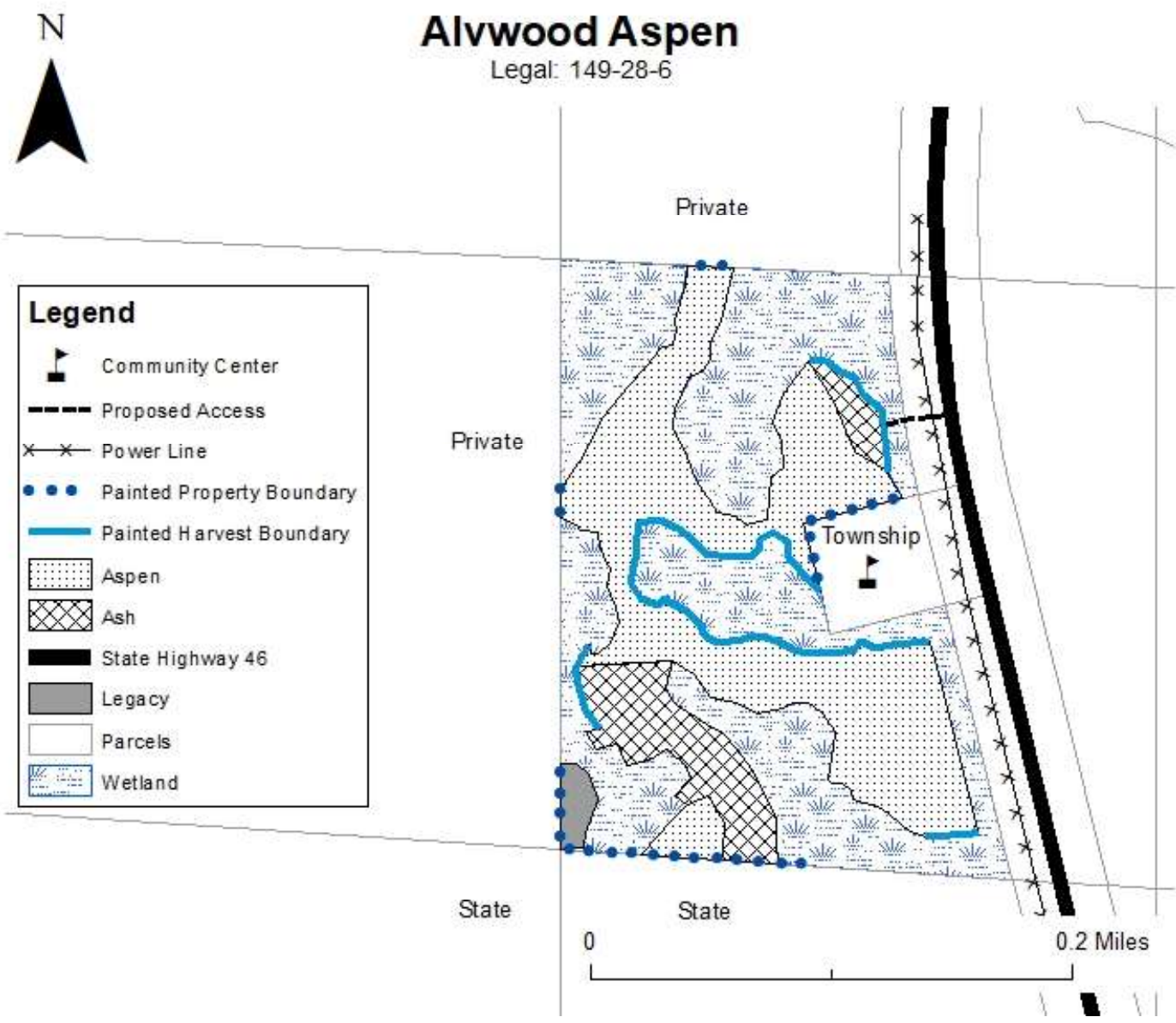
Harvest Specifications

Comments
Harvest Type: Aspen clearcut with reserves (8.5 ac) and black ash thin (2.2 ac).
Harvest and Reserves
Reserve all non-hazardous snags, den trees, trees painted with an orange "R" and non-merchantable trees. Cleacut all aspen, balm of Gilead and ash within the aspen stands. Cut all ash 8" and greater, all balm of Gilead and all aspen in the ash stands.
Access
The sale is 0.1 miles to State Highway 46. Proposed access off of Highway 46 - contact MNDOT for approval. "Caution Logging" signs may need to be placed on the highway.
Landings and Access Roads
Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator. Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition, determined by administering forester, before performance bond is returned.
Cutting, Felling, and Skidding
Do not fell timber across sale boundaries. Property boundaries are painted with 3 blue circles (o0o). Harvest boundaries are painted with 3 blue dashes (III) or are natural boundaries.
Slash Disposal
A 10 ft. wide slash free zone must be maintained along roads and trails.
Regeneration Plan
Natural regeneration.
