**Harvest Specifications**

Comments
Harvest Type = Aspen clearcut with reserves

Harvest and Reserves
Reserve all non-hazardous snags. Harvest all aspen, balm of Gilead, balsam, maple and birch. Reserve all other species.

Access
Federal must be crossed to access timber sale. Logger must obtain permits/ permission from land owner/ land manager.

Landings and Access Roads
Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed. Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator. Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition, determined by administering forester, before performance bond is returned.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding
Do not fell timber into wetlands or across sale boundaries. Do not damage reserve trees. Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees. Sale cutting boundaries painted are painted with orange slashes. Sale property boundaries painted with 3 orange circles.

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands.

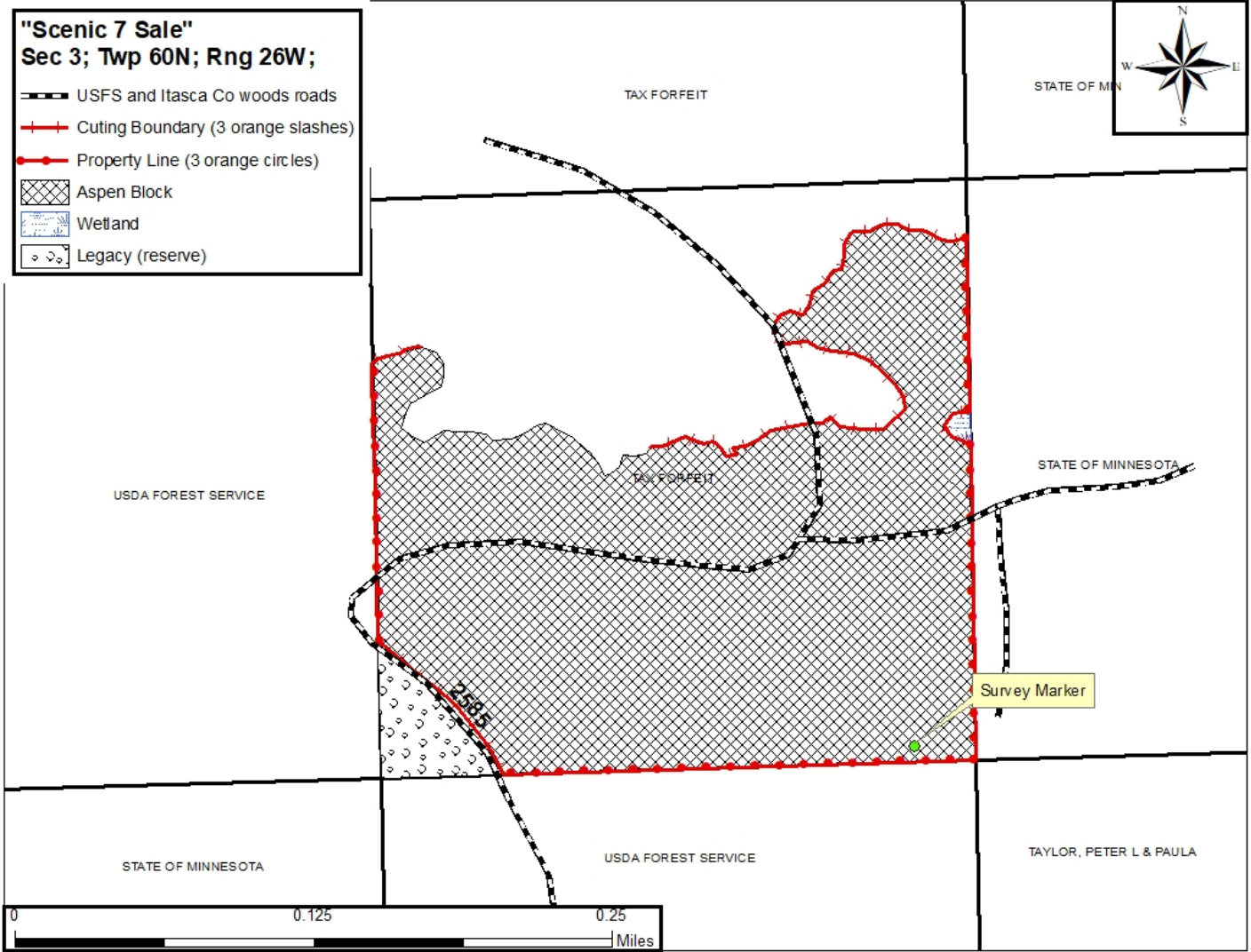
**Slash Disposal**
