Harvest Type: Aspen Clearcut with Reserves

#### **Harvest and Reserves**

Reserve: Spruce, Balsam, Oak, Ash, non-merchantable Maple within 15' of CR 16, non-merchantable hardwood within 15' of wetlands, and all non-hazardous snags.

Clearcut all stems of sale species within harvest area

#### Access

Sale is located on public road County Road 16.

#### **Landings and Access Roads**

Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition, determined by administering forester, before performance bond is returned.

Roads and landings must be approved by sale administrator.

#### Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Timber must be processed at the stump if harvested during non-frozen ground conditions.

Do not damage reserve trees.

Do not fell timber into wetlands or across sale boundaries.

Sale boundaries painted Orange Slashes (III) and property boundaries painted Orange Circles (oOo). Natural boundaries against CR 16

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Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands. Reserve all non-merchantable timber within 15ft of all wetlands.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area, and slash height must not exceed 3 ft. within view of road.


