Harvest Type = Aspen Clearcut with Reserves

Harvest and Reserves

Reserve White Pine, Elm, Balsam Fir < 2 sticks, 'R' painted trees, hardwood regeneration patches, and all non-hazardous snags. Clearcut all stems within 30 feet of any cut Aspen.

Access

1.0 miles to public road County Road 72.

Landings and Access Roads

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition, determined by administering forester, before performance bond is returned.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage reserve trees.

Sale boundaries painted Orange Slashes (III).

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Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50 feet of all wetlands.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

A 10 foot wide slash free zone must be maintained along roads and trails.


