Harvest type: clearcut with reserves.

Harvest and Reserves

Harvest: cut birch and balsam 3 sticks and over, plus all aspen, balm, red pine, and maple.

Reserve birch and balsam under 3 sticks and all basswood, white spruce, and red oak. Prioritize protection of oak and R trees when in conflict.

Trees marked with "R" are to be reserved for wildlife, seed source, or future crop trees.

Reserve all non-hazardous snags.

Access

5.5 miles to public road Hwy 1 via Holmstrom Spur state forest road.

Landings and Access Roads

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Landings must be kept back at least 100 feet from Valley River Road. No equipment operation or skidding will be permitted on/across the forest road.

Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

Natural regeneration to aspen and mixed northern hardwoods/conifers.


