Harvest Type: first time red pine thin (9 acres); second time red pine thin (3 acres).

Waiting to hear from US Fish & Wildlife concerning abandoned nest (3 acre block).

Harvest and Reserves

Reserve all maple, oak, white pine, non-hazardous snags, den trees, and reserve trees painted with an orange "R". An eagle nest is in the second time thin - nesting tree and surround trees are painted with an orange "R".

Access

Private/Easement road must be used to access the timber sale. Access road must be kept in good condition, as determined by administering forester, at all times.

Eastern stand is 0.25 miles to Wolf Lake Trail. Western stand is adjacent to East Wolf Lake Trail.

Landings and Access Roads

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition, determined by administering forester, before performance bond is returned.

Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

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Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not fell timber into wetlands or across sale boundaries.

Do not disturb survey marker, including 3 witness trees.

Property boundaries painted with 3 orange circles or an orange dash; rest are natural boundaries.

First time thin, clearcut 12 ft. access strips reserving 40 ft. in between strips for thinning. Between clearcut strips, thin to a 90 basal area. First, cut overtopping fir, aspen and jack pine within 10 feet of any red pine. Second, cut smaller diameter and/or poor quality red pine. Second time thin, remove smaller diameter and/or poor quality red pine. Thin to a 100 BA.

Do not damage reserve trees.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands.

Slash Disposal

A 10 ft. wide slash free zone must be maintained along roads and trails.

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

Special Conditions

Logging season may be restricted to August through February during high bark beetle risk. All cut pine must be hauled within 3 weeks during June through August.


