Harvest Type: clearcut with reserves.

Harvest and Reserves

Reserve all non-hazardous snags, den trees, and white pine.

Access

Sale adjacent to County Road 53.

Landings and Access Roads

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition, determined by administering forester, before performance bond is returned.

Landings must be kept back at least 100' from Wolf Lake Trail.

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Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not fell timber across sale boundaries.

Property boundaries are painted with 3 blue circles. Harvest boundaries are painted with 3 blue dashes. North line of legacy patch is painted with 3 orange dashes; ignore blue dashes north of legacy patch. Rest of boundaries are natural.

Cut stems greater than 2" at DBH.

Slash Disposal

Slash is to be piled in elongated rows 100 feet from County Road 53 and adjacent pine at administrator approved locations. 20% of tops and limbs must be scattered throughout the permit area per Site Level Forest Management Guideline. The 20% is in addition to incidental breakage.

A 10 ft. wide slash free zone must be maintained along roads and trails.

Special Conditions

Logging season may be restricted to August through February during high bark beetle risk. All cut pine must be hauled within 3 weeks during June through August.

Regeneration Plan

Regeneration will be jack pine planted with white pine component.


