Harvest and Reserves

Reserve pine, oak, cedar, yellow birch, and snags.

Access

It is the permit holder's responsibility to obtain approval from all affected landowners and/or management agencies before gaining access to the permit area. If applicable, the permit holder shall pay all access fees and road charges.

4.5 miles to Bakke Road.

Snowmobile trail regulations in Itasca County Forest Management Guideline & Specifications apply. A minimum of two inches of compacted snow must remain on the trail as a running surface.

Landings and Access Roads

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition, determined by administering forester, before performance bond is returned.

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Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Sale boundaries painted orange and natural boundaries.

Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.


