Harvest Type: aspen clearcut (93 acres), ash thin (2 acres)

Harvest and Reserves

Reserve all non-hazardous snags.

Trees marked with "R" are to be reserved for wildlife.

Aspen Type: Harvest all the species on the contract. Reserve all the others. Ash Type: Harvest 20 foot wide strips reserving 20 feet between the strips. Harvest only ash, aspen and balm within the ash type.

Access

There are 3 potential routes into this sale. 2 are through private land and one across tax forfeit lands. Purchaser is responsible for obtaining permits/permission to cross any private lands.

Snowmobile trail regulations in Itasca County Forest Management Guideline & Specifications apply. A minimum of two inches of compacted snow must remain on the trail as a running surface.

Landings and Access Roads

Roads and landings must be approved by sale administrator.

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Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage reserve trees.

Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees.

Sale cutting boundaries are painted with 3 orange lines.

Sale property boundaries are painted with 3 orange circles.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

Special Conditions

On the North end of the sale there are about 30 numbered trees in orange paint, those trees are to be harvested as part of the contract.

Regeneration Plan

Natural Regeneration to mixed aspen in the aspen stands. Natural regeneration back to ash in ash stands.


