Harvest and Reserves

Harvest all aspen, Balm, and ash. Reach into ash inclusions (painted out) to harvest ash >9" DBH, leaving a minimum basal area of 50. Reserve all other species.

Reserve all non-hazardous snags.

Trees marked with "R" are to be reserved for wildlife.

Access

Access has been obtained across private property.

Alternate access may be available from the south via Co Rd 234, through 1/4 mile LLIR land (old haul road).

Landings and Access Roads

Roads and landings must be approved by sale administrator.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage reserve trees.

Do not disturb survey markers, including witness trees.

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Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.


