Harvest Specifications

Comments
Harvest Type: aspen clearcut (12.6 acres)

Harvest and Reserves
Harvest all aspen, Balm, ash, basswood, maple, balsam, and paper birch. Reserve all other species.

Access
Federal / State / and possibly private must be crossed to access timber sale. Logger must obtain permits/ permission from land owner/ land manager.

Landings and Access Roads
Temporary water/wetland crossing needed on one or more locations. Remove crossing when harvesting activity is completed. Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding
Do not fell timber into wetlands or across sale boundaries. Sale property boundaries are painted with 3 orange circles and pink ribbon. Do not damage unmarked trees, regeneration, or reserve trees. Sale cutting boundaries are painted with 3 orange slashed.

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Site, Soil, and Water Protection
Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands.
Reserve all non-merchantable timber within 15ft of all wetlands.

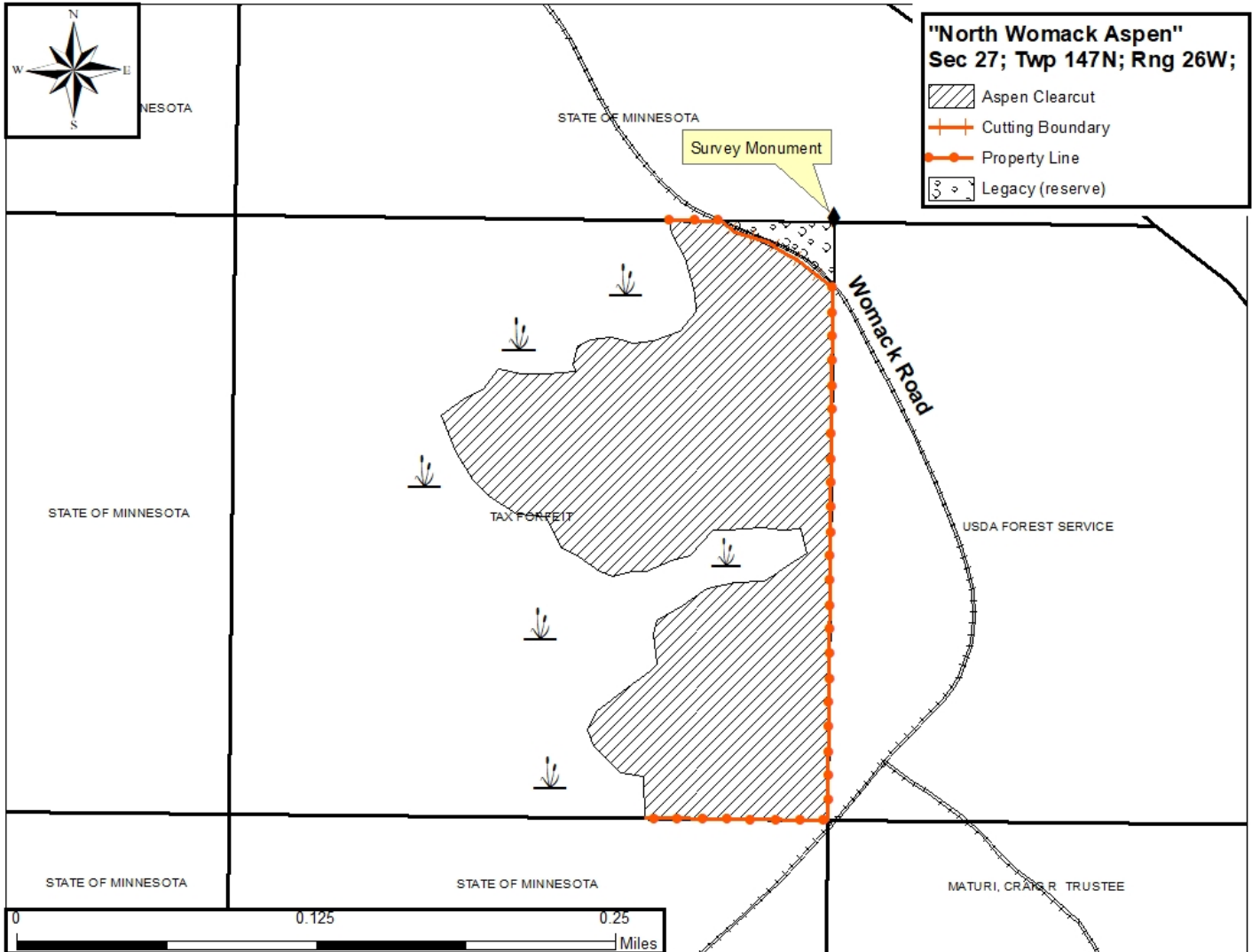
Slash Disposal
Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

Regeneration Plan
Natural Regeneration to mixed aspen.
