Harvest Type: Aspen clearcut with reserves

Harvest and Reserves

Harvest all aspen, balm, paper birch, ash, balsam and spruce. Reserve all oaks, cedar, & non- merchantable conifer in patches. Reserve all non-hazardous snags.

Access

Multiple possible accesses via private. It is the permit holder's responsibility to obtain approval from all affected landowners and/or management agencies before gaining access to the permit area. If applicable, the permit holder shall pay all access fees and road charges.

Landings and Access Roads

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Landings must be kept back at least 100' from county road 14.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not fell timber into wetlands or across sale boundaries. Sale property boundaries painted with orange circles.

Sale cutting boundaries are painted with orange slashes.

Itasca County forestlands are Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) Certified by NEPCon, NC-FM/COC-001709; FSC 100%

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Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50' of all wetlands. Reserve all non-merchantable timber within 15ft of all wetlands.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area. Slash height must not exceed 3 ft. within view of road.

Special Conditions

An old building foundation was detected and marked out with pink ribbon. No equipment travel permitted within the ribbon off area but you can reach in and cut the timber.


