Reserve all non-hazardous snags, den trees, cavity trees, pine, spruce, and oak.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not fell timber into wetlands or across sale boundaries.

Property boundaries painted are with 3 orange circles and harvest boundaries with 3 orange dashes. Rest are natural boundaries.

Cut all merchantable aspen, maple, ash, and paper birch.

Access

Snowmobile trail regulations in Itasca County Forest Management Guideline & Specifications apply. A minimum of two inches of compacted snow must remain on the trail as a running surface.

2 miles to County Road 50.

Blandin land must be crossed to access timber sale. Logger must obtain permits/permission from Blandin.

Landings and Access Roads

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition, determined by administering forester, before performance bond is returned.

Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.
