Harvest Guidelines Harvest Type: Aspen Clearcut w/reserves (24.5 ac.), Black Spruce Clearcut (1.5 ac.) Ash Thin (operator select, 3.5 ac.) marked Red Pine Thin (1ac.)

Reserve Guidelines

Reserve ash < 8" dbh, unmarked pine, elm, small balsam, all non-hazardous snags, den and cavity trees.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not fell timber into wetlands or across sale boundaries.

Sale has both orange painted and natural harvest boundaries.

On ash type or small ash inclusions, thin from above removing 50% of basal area on ash > 8" dbh. Leave 3 "plus ash trees" (large size and good form and condition) scattered on east ash type.on east

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Access

A portion of the access to west part of sale is used by snowmobile trail and also crosses main access trail. Snowmobile trail regulations in Itasca County Forest Management Guideline & Specifications apply. A minimum of two inches of compacted snow must remain on the trail as a running surface.

1.3 miles to County #55 to east part of sale, .5 miles additional to west part.

Landings and Access Roads

Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition, determined by administering forester, before performance bond is returned.

Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed. Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50 feet of all wetlands.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

A 10 foot wide slash free zone must be maintained along roads and trails.


