Harvest Guidelines

Harvest Type: Aspen Clearcut w/reserves (17.5 ac.), Ash Thin (3.5 ac., operator select).

Reserve Guidelines

Reserve ash< 8" dbh, elm, pine, small balsam, non-hazardous snags and den/cavity trees.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Some timber will require forwarding (no skidding) across Taconite Snowmobile Trail. Forester will need to be notified ahead of time and may need to be on site when this is occuring.

Most of sale boundaries painted orange.

On ash type, remove 50% of basal area on trees greater than 8" dbh. Thin from above, but retain a minimum of 6 "plus trees" (large with good form/condition) scattered within the stand.

Access

Snowmobile trail regulations in Itasca County Forest Management Guideline & Specifications apply. A minimum of two inches of compacted snow must remain on the trail as a running surface.

4 miles to public road #65 (Link Lk. Forest Road not plowed in winter).

Landings and Access Roads

Roads and landings must be approved by sale administrator.

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Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50 feet of all wetlands.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

A 10 foot wide slash free zone must be maintained along roads and trails.


