Harvest Type: Black Spruce and Jack Pine Clearcut with Reserves

Reserve Guidelines

Reserve all non-hazardous snags, den trees and cavity trees.

Reserves: White Pine, White Cedar, Balsam Fir <2 sticks

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage reserve trees.

Do not fell timber into wetlands or across sale boundaries.

Sale boundaries painted orange. Ignore all blue paint within harvest boundaries.

Access

0.5 miles to County Road 52.

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Landings and Access Roads

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition, determined by administering forester, before performance bond is returned.

Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

Special Conditions

All Black Spruce stems greater than 5ft. must be severed. Mistle Toe prevention

Regeneration Plan

Aerial seeding back to Black Spruce

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
