### Reserve Guidelines

Trees marked with "R" are to be reserved for wildlife.

Reserve all non-hazardous snags, den trees and cavity trees.

Reserve: oaks, basswood, conifers & elm.

## Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage reserve trees.

Harvest boundaries painted in blue(III). Property boundaries painted in blue(oOo). Pink Ribbon.

Do not fell timber into wetlands or across sale boundaries.

No driving, skidding, or landing on old buried dump sites- marked on map.

#### Access

Access off of the Spring Lake Landfill road. Safety signs will need to be posted for the duration of the timbersale harvest.

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### **Landings and Access Roads**

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Reserve all non-merchantable timber within 15 feet of all roads.

Landings must be kept back at least 100 feet from county rd 4.

Berm(s) must be installed after sale is completed.

Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition, determined by administering forester, before performance bond is returned.

## Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50 feet of all wetlands.

#### Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

A 10 foot wide slash free zone must be maintained along roads and trails.

Slash height must not exceed 3 feet within view of road.


