Harvest Specifications

Harvest Guidelines

Harvest Type: Aspen/birch/red pine clearcut with reserves.

Harvest Type: Blue paint marked red/white pine seed tree harvest. Harvest all pine marked with blue rings.

Reserve Guidelines

Reserve all non-hazardous snags, den trees and cavity trees.

Trees marked with "R" are to be reserved for wildlife.

Reserve: Unmarked white pine, oaks, white spruce <4 sticks & -R- painted trees.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage reserve trees.

Property boundaries painted in orange circles(oOo), cutting boundaries orangeslashes(III) along with pink ribbon.

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Access

Access is along public roadway(county hwy 60, wolf pack path). Public water access/Easement road to private property must be used to access the timber sale. Access road must be kept in good condition, as determined by administering forester, at all times.

Landings and Access Roads

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Berm(s) must be installed after sale is completed.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

Filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50 feet of all wetlands.

Slash Disposal

Slash is to be piled at administrator approved locations. 20% of tops and limbs must be scattered throughout the permit area per Site Level Forest Management Guideline. The 20% is in addition to incidental breakage.

Slash height must not exceed 3 feet within view of road.

A 10 foot wide slash free zone must be maintained along roads and trails.

Special Conditions

Logging season may be restricted to August through February during high bark beetle risk. All cut pine must be hauled within 3 weeks during June through August.

Regeneration Plan

Planting sites to red & white pine.


