Harvest Guidelines

Harvest Type: Clearcut w/reserves

Harvest all aspen, ash, and maple within the permit area. In addition, harvest all balsam with 3 and greater sticks.

Reserve Guidelines

Reserve all birch, pine, basswood, oak, spruce and balsam fir with 2 or fewer sticks.

Reserve all non-hazardous snags.

Trees marked with "R" are to be reserved for wildlife.

Cutting, Felling, and Skidding

Do not damage reserve trees.

Do not fell timber into wetlands or across sale boundaries.

Sale boundaries are painted using orange paint. Natural boundaries, without paint, are also used for this permit.

Access

Access is along public roadways.

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Landings and Access Roads

Location and construction of any new roads/landings must be pre-approved by the sale administrator.

Trails and landings need to be rehabilitated to a satisfactory condition, determined by administering forester, before performance bond is returned

Reserve all non-merchantable timber within 15 feet of Reilly Beach Road.

Berm(s) must be installed after sale is completed.

Landings must be kept back at least 100 feet from Reilly Beach Road.

Timber sale administrator shall be notified at least 3 working days prior to completion of hauling and road work. This provides adequate time for permit area inspection and addressing of permit compliance requirements before hauling and road work equipment is removed.

Site, Soil, and Water Protection

If wetlands are found filter strips require <5% soil disturbance within 50 feet of all wetlands.

Reserve all non-merchantable timber within 15 feet of all wetlands.

Slash Disposal

Slash must be evenly distributed throughout permit area.

Regeneration Plan

Regeneration is to be accomplished by way of aspen coppice and by seed from adjacent stand/reserve species.

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
